

By plane:

Sevenair operates flights to Vila Real or Bragança from Viseu, Cascais, and Portimão, with two daily flights. From Vila Real or Bragança, it is then possible to rent a car or take a bus to Mirandela.

For international flights, the closest airport is Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport (Porto). From Porto, it is possible to take a bus to Mirandela (see below) or rent a car. From Oviedo (OVD), it is possible to fly to Porto (OPO) with one stop. There are direct flights from Madrid to Porto operated by several airlines, with a flight duration of approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes.

Once at Porto Airport, you should take a bus to Mirandela. Companies such as Rede-Expressos and FlixBus offer this service. The bus journey from Porto Airport to Mirandela takes approximately 2 to 3 hours.

By train:

Unfortunately, the Tua railway line is currently inactive. For those travelling from Spain, it is possible to take the high-speed train between Madrid and Zamora and then continue to Mirandela by rental car or bus.

By bus:

Alsa operates a route from Oviedo to Mirandela, usually requiring one transfer. Total travel time may vary but is generally between 7 and 16 hours, depending on the connection. Buses depart from Oviedo Bus Station and arrive at Mirandela Bus Terminal.

Alsa also offers routes from Madrid to Mirandela. Depending on the schedule, trips may be direct or include one stop. Travel time is approximately 4 hours 30 minutes to 5 hours 30 minutes. Buses usually depart from Madrid South Bus Station.

Companies such as Rede-Expressos and FlixBus offer services between Porto Airport and Mirandela. The bus journey takes approximately 2 to 3 hours.

The Mirandela Bus Terminal is located about a five-minute walk from ESACT.

By car:

Within Portugal, the best option is to take the A4 motorway, which runs directly from Porto to Mirandela. The journey takes approximately 1 hour 30 minutes to 2 hours. It is also possible to travel from the south via Viseu, using the A24 and then joining the A4 near Vila Real, with a total travel time of around 1 hour 30 minutes.

From Spain, travelling from Oviedo covers a distance of approximately 366 km, with an estimated driving time of 3 hours 48 minutes, depending on traffic conditions. The main route follows the A-66.

The drive from Madrid to Mirandela is approximately 411 km, with an estimated travel time of 4 hours 16 minutes, mainly via the A-6.

Getting around Mirandela:

Mirandela is a largely flat city, making it very easy to get around on foot or by bicycle. Taxis are available in the city, particularly at the bus terminal near EsACT-IPB and at the taxi rank in Parque do Império.

There is also a city bus service that circulates through the main areas of the city. Stops and schedules can be found here:
